AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has not intentionally avoided to appear before the trial Court and had moved an application for exemption for appearance before the Court on 27.11.2017. He contends that the next date of hearing before the trial Court is 20.01.2018, on which date, he shall appear before the trial Court. He further submits that the petitioner shall not absent himself on any of the dates which may be subsequently fixed by the Court during the trial. He undertakes that the absence of the petitioner on any ground on subsequent dates may revive the order of cancellation of bail/surety bonds.

In view of the undertaking given by the counsel for the petitioner, in case the petitioner appears before the trial Court on 20.01.2018 and files an undertaking before the trial Court that henceforth, he will appear on each and every date fixed by the Court for trial, the trial Court

shall accept the bail/surety bonds to its satisfaction and shall cancel the same, in case of absence of the petitioner on any date fixed by the trial Court.

The present petition is disposed of with above observations/directions.
