Petitioner seeks quashing of FIR No. 332, dated 09.11.2015 under Sections 394, 506 IPC, registered at Police Station, Sector 31, Chandigarh and other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise.

Vide order dated 21.04.2018 this Court had directed the parties to appear before the trial Court for getting recorded their statements with regard to compromise, so as to ascertain genuineness of the compromise.

Report of learned JMIC, Chandigarh has been received, wherein it has been stated that pursuant to the order dated 21.04.2018 passed by this Court, statements of complainant Anil Kumar along with accused Vinod Kumar, Rajesh Kumar, Hari Om @ Chila and Ajay @ Bora have been recorded and as per the said statements, the compromise has been effected amongst them. The learned trial Court in its report has opined that the compromise arrived at between the parties appears to be genuine and had been effected voluntarily, without any pressure or coercion and with free will of the parties.

In view of the aforesaid position, this Court is satisfied that the matter has been resolved amicably. As such, the petition is hereby accepted and the FIR and all subsequent proceedings are ordered to be quashed.
