On December 09, 2014 following order had been recorded:-

“Counsel for the parties inform that both the parties have died and their legal representatives are required to be brought on record. Request has been made for moving CMs for bringing legal representatives of the parties on record.

Adjourned to 13.1.2015.”

Thereafter though the legal representatives of the respondent were impleaded in his place as per the order of August 19, 2015, no application has been filed seeking to implead the legal representatives of the appellant.

Mr. Sharma, learned counsel for the appellant, submits that though he had written a letter at the address of the late appellant, he has received no reply thereto, possibly because the address may have changed in the past 29 years this appeal being of the year 1989.

That being so, for lack of alternative, this appeal is dismissed in

default, with however liberty granted to the LR's of the appellant to revive it within a reasonable time, if they wish.
