This is an application for preponement of the actual date of hearing in the main case.

Application is allowed as prayed for and the main case is taken up today itself.

CRM-M-15739-2017

The vehicle was taken into custody by the police on the allegation that 32 boxes and 25 bottles of English liquor were transported. An application was filed before the trial court which was dismissed with following observation:-

“Heard on application for releasing one vehicle bearing registration No.CH-03-Y-0775 on Sapurdari. Police report has been perused. Investigation Agency has no objections on releasing of the vehicle. Perusal of the file shows that vehicle, when was intercepted, was found to be containing 32 boxes of liquor. So vehicle having been used for transportation of illicit liquor without any license, there is every possibility that vehicle if release might be used for same purpose. Application, as such stands dismissed.”

To the mind of this court, the said vehicle is not required for custody. As such, the same may be returned to the registered owner subject to the conditions imposed by the trial court.

Disposed of accordingly.
