The petitioners seek quashing of DDR No.42 dated 24.02.2018 under Sections 379-B(1) 341, 323, 324, 336, 506 and 307 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Sections 25, 27, 54, 59 of Arms Act in FIR No.45 dated 24.02.2018 under Sections 452, 323, 307, 148, 149 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Sections 25, 27, 54, 59 of Arms Act, Police Station City Kapurthala, District Kapurthala and proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.

Vide order dated 07.08.2018 the parties had been directed to

appear before the trial Court/Illaqa Magistrate so as to get the statements recorded with regard to the genuineness of the compromise.

Report of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Kapurthala has been received wherein it has been reported that statements of the petitioners as well as of complainant-Robin Sahota and injured namely Ajay and Mandeep Kumar @ Deepa have been recorded who have stated that they have compromised the matter and that complainant and injured have no objection if the FIR is quashed. It has specifically been opined by Chief Judicial Magistrate, Kapurthala that the compromise is genuine and has been effected voluntarily without there being any undue influence or coercion.

In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the petition is allowed and DDR No.42 dated 24.02.2018 under Sections 379-B(1) 341, 323, 324, 336, 506 and 307 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Sections 25, 27, 54, 59 of Arms Act in FIR No.45 dated 24.02.2018 under Sections 452, 323, 307, 148, 149 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Sections 25, 27, 54, 59 of Arms Act, Police Station City Kapurthala, District Kapurthala and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
