GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.442 dated 31.10.2012 under Sections 148, 149, 332, 353, 186, 506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, Police Station Narnaund, District Hisar and proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.

Vide order dated 23.04.2018 the parties had been directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate so as to get the statements recorded with regard to factum of compromise.

Report of learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Hansi, has been received wherein it has been reported that statement of complainant-Rajesh and also of the accused persons namely Kuldeep, Dinesh, Anil alias Kala, Basau, Raja, Anil and Ram Mehar have been recorded, who had stated that they have sorted out all the differences and that the compromise has been effected with the intervention of the respectables. It has specifically been opined that the compromise effected between the parties appears to have been entered into voluntarily without any pressure or inducement and that there is nothing to suggest that the compromise has been effected under fear, threat, pressure or coercion.

In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the petition is allowed and FIR No.442 dated 31.10.2012 under Sections 148, 149, 332, 353, 186, 506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, Police Station Narnaund, District Hisar and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed.
