Heard.

It is alleged in FIR that complainant entered into agreement with Daljit Singh, husband of petitioner, for sale of 23 acres of land and received Rs. 2,40,000/-. Daljit Singh got 11 ½ acres of land, standing in name of his wife Kulwinder Kaur, transferred in name of petitioner. However, he did not get remaining land transferred. FIR shows that agreement was with Daljit Singh and not with petitioner, though she transferred the land standing in her name.

Prima facie, it appears to be a civil dispute. In any case, custodial interrogation of petitioner is not required. She has already joined investigation and disclose all facts to police. As such, petition for grant of

anticipatory bail to petitioner is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on her furnishing personal bond in the sum of Rs. 50,000/- with one surety of like amount to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer.
