AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner has approached this Court for taking action on the complaint dated 27.03.2018 (Annexure P-3) addressed to the Superintendent of Police, Amritsar (Rural), which is alleged to have been marked to the SHO, Police Station Kamboj, District Amritsar.

What is asserted by the petitioner is that he is being called everyday in the Police Station and is being forced to withdraw the complaint at the behest of the accused.

Perusal of the complaint dated 27.03.2018 (Annexure P-3) does not indicate that petitioner had earlier approached the SHO, however, since the complaint is alleged to have been marked to the SHO by the Superintendent of Police by No.366-AP, as referred to in para 4 of the petition, the same be looked into by the competent authority and appropriate action be taken, if required.

The present petition stands disposed of accordingly.
