Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that earlier on the complaint of the petitioner, an FIR No.214 was registered on 06.06.2013 under Sections 323, 324, 34 IPC in Police Station Sarai Khawaja. The trial of the said case is pending before the competent Court. Thereafter, FIR No.274 dated 29.03.2018 has been registered under Sections 323, 34, 342, 379-B, 427, 506 IPC against the private respondents in the same police station.

Though the investigation of the case shall take its own course but private respondents are pressurizing the petitioner to effect compromise.

Precisely for the grievance in question, petitioner has

already moved a representation before respondent No.3 on 05.04.2018 but no action has been taken.

On the asking of Court, Mr. S.P. Singh, D.A.G., Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4.

In view of nature of order, which this Court proposes to pass there is no necessity of filing any reply, as no order prejudicial to the interest of either party is being passed.

At this stage, without embarking upon merits of the case, it would be appropriate to ask respondent No.3 to have a fair look on the grievance of the petitioner and pass appropriate order in accordance with law without being influenced by any statement of fact made hereinabove.
