Petitioner seeks benefit of regular bail pending trial in case FIR No.15, dated 26.01.2017 under Sections 302/120-B IPC registered at Police Station, Nehianwala, District Bathinda.

During the course of hearing today, it has gone uncontroverted that co-accused, namely, Shingara Singh, against whom there was similar role, has been granted bail by this Court in the light of order dated 09.02.2018 passed in *CRM-M-46891 of 2017* titled as 'Shingara Singh Vs. State of Punjab'.

In the considered view of this Court and on the ground of parity itself, the reasoning adopted by this Court in the order dated 09.02.2018 while granting bail to co-accused Singara Singh would also apply to the present petitioner as well.

Accordingly, present petition is allowed in terms of the order dated 09.02.2018 passed in *CRM-M-46891 of 2017*.

Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
