The petitioner, namely, Kuldeep Singh seeks anticipatory bail in complaint case bearing No.879 dated 11.06.2014 titled as 'Parvesh Kumar Gupta Vs. Kuldeep Singh' pending in the Court of Judicial Magistrate First Class, Patiala.

The abovementioned complaint was filed under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instrument Act, 1881. Notice thereof was issued to the petitioner, but he did not appear before the Court. Ultimately, vide order dated 23.11.2015 (Annexure P-2), he was declared as proclaimed offender. Now, this petition has been filed seeking anticipatory bail.

Order dated 23.11.2015 (Annexure P-2), has not been challenged by the petitioner. Without challenging the same, no relief can be granted to him. In any case, petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C is not the remedy available in law, since the offence under Section 138 of Negotiable Instrument Act, 1881, is bailable.

The present petition is mis-conceived and is accordingly dismissed.
