In the instant petition, petitioners have sought for the following relief:-

“Petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for the issuance of directions to the respondents No.3 and 4 for fairly and properly investigate the case FIR No.246 dated 20.12.2016 under Sections 148/307/23/427/452 and 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Babain, District Kurukshetra or to transfer the investigation of the case to some other independent investigating agency or to the Crime Branch of CBI for just and fair investigation as the police is having hand in glove with the accused party.”

2.) During pendency of the present petition, much water has flown in the FIR No.246 dated 20.12.2016 to the extent of filing challan in two

installments, namely on 22.5.2017 and 10.06.2017. Thereafter, certain proceedings have already been in vogue. Therefore, petitioners' grievance relating to proper investigation and/or in the alternative to transfer the investigation to some other independent investigating agency do not survive for consideration.

3.) Accordingly, petition stands disposed of. Reserving liberty to the petitioners to approach appropriate forum if they are still aggrieved by the investigation and further reports, if any.
