The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking regular on behalf of the petitioner bail in case FIR No.38 dated 10th February, 2017, registered under Sections 186, 332, 353, 307 of the Indian Penal Code read with Section 25 of the Arms Act at Police Station Sadar Gohana, District Sonapat.

2. The petitioner was arrested on 10th February, 2017.
3. Investigation completed and challan submitted.
4. Co-accused, namely Vikas @ Vicky, who stands on virtually identical footing with the petitioner according to the FIR, was ordered to be released on bail vide a detailed order passed by a

Co-ordinate Bench of this Court in CRM-M No.34861 of 2017 on 6th October, 2017.

5. The same reasoning in the case is fully applicable to the present petitioner as well, who has in the meantime undergone further detention for almost 04 months after the co-accused was granted bail.

6. The present petitioner, namely Sagar may therefore be released on the same bail's terms and conditions with liberty to the prosecution to apply for cancellation, if so warranted under any special circumstances.
