Petitioner seeks benefit of regular bail pending trial in FIR No. 0035 dated 10.04.2017 under Section 22 of NDPS Act and under Sections 420, 465, 468, 471 and 474 IPC registered at Police Station Lohian District Jalandhar.

Counsel for the parties have been heard.

As per prosecution version, an alleged recovery of 1.5 kgs of dextropropoxyphene hydrochloride was effected.

The recovery effected from the petitioner would be construed as heavy and commercial quantity.

In the light of the specific bar envisaged under Section 37 of the NDPS Act, this Court is not inclined to extend in favour of the petitioner benefit of bail.

Petition dismissed.
