The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.91 dated 14th October, 2017, registered under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Mansa, District Mansa.

2. The complaint was lodged on behalf of the Axis Bank.

3. Vide a separate order passed by this Court in CRM-M No.15829 of 2017 today, the interim anticipatory bail of the petitioner in somewhat circumstances has been confirmed by this Court.

4. In the present case, the role of the petitioner is even less limited. She was not even an applicant for loan which was granted in favour of her husband-Tarsem Singh, who thereafter allegedly siphoned off the amount in question to their joint account.

5. As such there is no tangible ground to justify her detention at this stage.

6. Consequently, the interim bail granted to the present petitioner earlier is hereby confirmed.
