DAYA CHAUDHARY, J.(ORAL)

Through the present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks regular bail in case FIR No.151, dated 21.10.2016, registered under Sections 15/29 of NDPS Act at Police Station Model Town, Hoshiarpur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in the case whereas he was not involved. Petitioner is in custody since 21.10.2016 and there is violation of provisions of Section 50 of the NDPS Act which is mandatory. He also submits that there is no progress in the trial and trial may take long time to conclude as only five witnesses have been examined.

Learned State counsel submits that out of total 15 witnesses, five have been examined, three have been given up and remaining witnesses are to be examined today. Earlier application was dismissed as

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withdrawn on 21.11.2016 and trial is likely to be concluded. By considering that the petitioner is in custody since 21.10.2016, the trial Court is directed to make all efforts to conclude the trial preferably within a period of two months.
