This petition has been filed by the petitioner under section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.161, dated 29.09.2017, under sections 21/25/29 of NDPS Act, 1985, and sections 307, 332, 353, 186 IPC and section 25 of Arms Act 1959, registered at Police Station Sadar Patti, District Tarn Taran.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been named in this case on the statement of a co-accused and that he was not arrested on the spot as he was in custody in some other case. The investigation is complete and challan has already been presented in the Court. Co-accused-Shinder Singh has been granted regular bail by this Court vide order dated 23.03.2018, passed in **CRM-M-11508-2018**. Thus, the petitioner be also granted regular bail.

3. Learned State counsel however, submits that the petitioner is accused of having been found in possession of the receipts of sale of drugs and a sum of Rupees Four lacs, were recovered from the house of the petitioner. He further

submits that he is also an accused in another case under NDPS Act and thus he is not entitled for the concession of regular bail.

4. Keeping in view the fact that the investigation is complete and that co-accused Shinder Singh has already been granted regular bail, I deem it appropriate to grant the same concession to the petitioner as well.

5. Thus, the petition is allowed. Petitioner-Gurmej Singh alias Geju son of Joginder Singh alias Gabber, is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court concerned at Tarn Taran.
