The petitioner-Ved Parkash @ Manav Tanurag, seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No.28, dated 10.01.2018, under sections 21/18/18-C/22 of NDPS Act, 1985 and sections 18(C) and 18(A) of Drugs and Cosmetic Act, 1940, registered at Police Station City Sirsa, District Sirsa.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the FIR is dated 10.01.2018, and the petitioner has been arrested on 09.03.2018 on the basis of a disclosure statement. However, nothing has been recovered from the petitioner. The investigation is complete and the challan has also been presented and therefore, the petitioner deserves to be released on regular bail.

3. Learned State counsel does not dispute the aforementioned factual averment of learned counsel for the petitioner.

4. Keeping in view the totality and facts and circumstances of the case, I deem it just and appropriate to release the petitioner on regular bail. Thus, the petition

is allowed. petitioner-Ved Parkash @ Manav Tanurag, is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court concerned at Sirsa.
