Petitioner seeks benefit of regular bail pending trial in case FIR No.11, dated 09.02.2017 under Sections 302, 307, 353, 186, 212, 216, 148, 149 IPC and under Section 25/54/59 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station, Sadar Ahmedgarh, District Sangrur.

Counsel for the parties have been heard at length.

As per prosecution version, secret information had been received by SI Kulwant Kaur that two gangsters had taken shelter in the house of the present petitioner. Based on such secret information, the police party had encircled the house of the petitioner and whereupon it is alleged that the petitioner along with co-accused, namely, Jagdeep Singh @ Deepu had tried to flee away and had even resorted to firing and in which one Bikram @ Bobby suffered gun shot injuries and to which he succumbed. Case of the prosecution is that deceased Bikram @ Bobby was one of the assailants who were trying to flee away from the house of the petitioner.

Petitioner was arrested on 09.02.2017.

Investigation in the case is complete and challan has already been presented. Charges are yet to be framed.

Learned State counsel, who is on instructions from ASI Basir does not controvert the contention raised by counsel for the petitioner that in the firing that took place, none of the officials of the police party had suffered any fire arm injury.

Trial in the case would take time to conclude.

Co-accused, namely, Jagdeep Singh @ Deepu has been granted bail by this Court in the light of the order dated 20.03.2018 passed in *CRM-M-6947 of 2018* titled as 'Jagdeep Singh @ Deepu Vs. State of Punjab'.

Without making any observation on merits, petitioner is held entitled to the benefit of bail.

Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

Disposed of.
