This is a petition under section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail in Case FIR No.370, dated 08.12.2017, under section 326 IPC, registered at Police Station Sector 31, Chandigarh.

Learned counsel for U.T., Chandigarh, on instructions from SI Ragvir Singh, submits that investigation has revealed that the injury received by the complainant was in self-defence. However, it is not disputed that pursuant to the order dated 12.03.2018, the petitioner has joined investigation and that he is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 12.03.2018, is hereby made absolute.
