The present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.226 dated 08.04.2018 registered under Section 8 of the Haryana Prohibition of Cow Slaughter Act, 1972 and 13(1) of The Haryana Gausvansh Sanrakshan and Gausamvardhan Act, 2015 at Police Station Gharaunda, District Karnal.

On 26.04.2018, this Court has passed the following order:-

“Learned State Counsel seeks time to verify as to whether there are other cases of the similar nature

pending against the petitioner.

On his request, adjourned to 28.05.2018.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to join the investigation before the Investigating Officer. In the event of his arrest, the Arresting Officer would admit him to interim bail till the next date of hearing on his furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to his satisfaction. The petitioner is also directed to abide by all the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that in terms of the order dated 26.04.2018, the petitioner has joined investigation on 16.05.2018 and his custodial interrogation is no longer required.

The above factual position is duly acknowledged by learned State counsel and stated that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is no longer required.

In view of the above, the order dated 26.04.2018 is made absolute subject to the provisions of Section 438(2) Cr. P.C.

Petition stands disposed off.
