Learned senior counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would appear in Court tomorrow, i.e. 25.04.2018 and seek regular bail. It is, further submitted that henceforth, the petitioner will not seek exemption unless on account of circumstances beyond her control.

The petitioner was granted regular bail by the learned trial Court. However, vide order dated 05.04.2018 (Annexure P-7), her bail was cancelled and bail bonds and surety bonds were forfeited for the reason that the petitioner was seeking exemption on each and every date, even though, she was medically fit. This petition has been necessitated on account of said order.

Mr. K.S. Sidhu, accepts notice on behalf of the State of Punjab. Let two copies of the petition be supplied to him during the course of the day.

The petition is disposed of with direction to the petitioner to surrender before the learned trial Court tomorrow i.e. on 25.04.2018 and

seek regular bail, which shall be granted to her by the trial Court to its satisfaction.

It is also noted that the petitioner shall remain bound by the statement made by her through her counsel.
