Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.155 dated 09.10.2017 under Sections 15/61/85 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Lambran, District Jalandhar Rural.

On 25.04.2018, following order was passed by this Court: -

“Notice of motion for 6th July, 2018.

On asking of the Court, Ms. Rajni Gupta, Sr. Deputy Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. A copy of the paper-book be handed over to her during the course of the day.

In the meantime, the petitioner may surrender before the ld. trial Court and may be admitted to interim bail.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was

on regular bail and was regularly appearing before the trial Court, however, on account of his non-appearance on 22.12.2017, her bail/surety bonds were cancelled. Counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner has already put in appearance before the trial Court, in compliance of the aforesaid order and is facing the trial.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Kulwinder Singh, has not disputed the aforesaid factual position.

Though the earlier petition i.e. CRM-M-10736-2018, praying for setting aside the order dated 22.12.2017, was dismissed on 14.03.2018, yet considering the fact that the Coordinate Bench has directed the petitioner to appear before the trial Court and he was granted interim bail, present petition is disposed of and the order dated 25.04.2018 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.
