The petitioner seeks anticipatory bail. He was summoned in a complaint case and according to learned counsel he was not served. The learned trial Court erroneously declared him as proclaimed offender in the year 2015. On acquiring knowledge of the said order, the petitioner sought anticipatory bail in the year 2016 but the same was rejected. He seeks the indulgence of this Court to enable the petitioner to appear before the learned trial Court on 30.04.2018.

It is apparent that since the year 2016, the petitioner has absconded from the law. Therefore, he does not qualify for any relief at the hands of this Court.

However, in case petitioner surrenders before the learned trial Court on 30.04.2018 and seeks regular bail, the trial Court shall consider the application sympathetically.
