The present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.117 dated 14.04.2015 registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Sector-5, Panchkula.

It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that in pursuance of order dated 25.04.2018, the petitioner has joined investigation on 27.04.2018 and his custodial interrogation is no longer required.
