Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.26 dated 18.03.2018 under Section 420 IPC, registered at Police Station Kalanaur, District Gurdaspur.

While granting interim bail to the petitioner, following order was passed on 25.04.2018: -

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that a perusal of the FIR shows that no date has been given when the amount of Rs.60,000/- was allegedly paid by the complainant to the petitioner. It is further submitted that the FIR has been registered only as a counter-blast of an incident, which was compromised between the parties on 09.08.2017, as the complainant party had entered the house of the petitioner and extended threats and later on, the panchayat got the matter compromised.

Notice of motion for 20.08.2018.”

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Vaishno Dass, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 25.04.2018 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
