Petitioner seeks benefit of regular bail pending trial in case FIR No.205, dated 02.06.2017 under Sections 386, 506 read with Section 34 IPC, registered at Police Station, Tosham, District Bhiwani.

Counsel for the parties have been heard at length.

FIR came to be registered on the statement of Ajit Singh son of Vijay Singh. It was alleged that the complainant was working in a wine company and on 01.06.2017, present petitioner along with 4/5 other boys came to the office of the wine company in the late evening hours and demanded a sum of Rs.1 lakh to continue the business venture. At that stage, complainant telephoned his friends and whereupon the assailants including the petitioner fled away from the spot leaving their vehicle behind.

Petitioner was arrested on 04.07.2017.

Investigation in the case is complete and challan stands presented.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI-Krishan Kumar, would oppose the prayer for regular bail by submitting that the petitioner is a habitual offender and is involved in seven other cases.

However, it has gone uncontroverted that in five matters, trial has culminated in the acquittal of the petitioner and in one case petitioner was convicted and against which revision is pending for final adjudication and sentence of the petitioner has been suspended. In one matter, petitioner is facing trial, but has been granted concession of bail.

Trial in the case would take time to conclude.

Without making any observation on merits, petitioner is held entitled to the benefit of bail.

Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned, provided that he is not required in custody in any other case.
