Counsel for the petitioners has asserted that under the influence of respondent No. 5-Manjit Singh, Assistant Commissioner of Police (South), Amritsar, petitioners are being called upon to vacate the plot, which is owned and possessed by the petitioners, for which petitioners have also initiated suit for permanent injunction restraining respondents No. 6 and 7 from interference into the peaceful and lawful possession over the plot in question. Petitioners are, time and again, being summoned to Police Station Division No. 'C' Amritsar and made to sit for the whole day rather they are being pressurized to hand over the possession to respondents No. 6 and 7 of the plot.

Counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners, at this stage, would be satisfied if their representation dated 20.04.2018 (Annexure

P-2), which has been addressed to the Director General of Police, Punjab with a copy to the Inspector General, Border Range, Amritsar as well as Commissioner of Police, Amritsar, is looked into and appropriate steps, in accordance with law, are taken and in any case, the petitioners, if required, may be given a proper notice under Section 160 Cr. P.C.

Without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, the present petition is disposed of with directions to the Inspector General, Border Range, Amritsar and the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar, respondents No. 3 and 4 respectively to look into the representation of the petitioners dated 20.04.2018 (Annexure P-2) and if need be, to take appropriate steps in accordance with law. In any case, if the petitioners are required for enquiry or other purpose, a proper notice under Section 160 Cr. P.C. be issued to them.
