This order shall dispose of CRM-M-17073-2018, filed by petitioner-Ashok Kumar, CRM-M-19300-2018, filed by petitioners-Reeta Garg @ Reetu and Nisha Garg and CRM-M-19374-2018, filed by petitioners-Manish Garg and Parveen Kumar, under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.11 dated 05.02.2018, registered at Police Station Women Panipat, District Panipat, under Sections 323, 452, 506 and 34 IPC and Sections 325 and 120-B IPC added later on.

Notice of motion was issued in all these petitions. Learned State counsel put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested these petitions.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

At the time of arguments, it has been brought into notice of this Court that challan has been presented without arresting the petitioners. In pursuance of the summonses issued to the petitioners, they have already appeared before the trial Court and have been released on interim bail. The petitioners are now not required for custodial interrogation. They are only to face the trial.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find that no useful

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purpose will be served by sending the petitioners to custody. Therefore, finding merit in these petitions, the same are allowed. The orders dated 25.04.2018 passed in CRM-M-17073-2018, dated 07.05.2018 passed in CRM-M-19300-2018 and dated 08.05.2018 passed in CRM-M-19374-2018, granting interim bail to the petitioners, are made absolute.
