Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in compliance of order dated 17.1.2018, the petitioner has joined the investigation and has also deposited the amount.

The factum of joining the investigation and deposition of money has been affirmed by learned State counsel on instructions from HC Ranjit Singh.

Learned counsel for the complainant contends that till date the petitioner has not told as to where the goods were taken.

The allegations are matter of evidence and the same can be seen during trial.

Since the petitioner has joined the investigation and also deposited the value of the goods, interim order dated 17.1.2018 passed by this Court in favour of the petitioner is made absolute.
