It is the contention of the learned counsel for the petitioners that the life and liberty of the petitioners is at jeopardy at the hands of respondents No. 4 to 6. It is asserted that highlighting the said aspect, petitioners have submitted a representation dated 15.04.2018 (Annexure P-5) to the Superintendent of Police, Yamuna Nagar-respondent No. 2. He contends that a fresh representation will also be submitted to the Station House Officer, Police Station Farakpur, District Yamuna Nagar -respondent No. 3. Prayer has been made for protecting the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No. 4 to 6 with a direction to Superintendent of Police, Yamuna Nagar-respondent No. 2 and the Station House Officer, Police Station Farakpur, District Yamuna Nagar -respondent No. 3 for the said purpose.

Without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, in case the life and liberty of the petitioners is at jeopardy at the hands of respondents No. 4 to 6, which is highlighted in the representation dated 15.04.2018 (Annexure P-5) addressed to the Superintendent of Police, Yamuna Nagar-respondent No. 2, the same shall be looked into and appropriate action taken in accordance with law. The Station House Officer, Police Station Farakpur, District Yamuna Nagar -respondent No. 3, if approached by the petitioners, would also do the same.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
