Petitioner seeks issuance of necessary directions to respondent No.2 in the context of protecting her life, personal liberty and property.

Petitioner has raised pointed allegations against respondents No.4 and 5. Name of respondent No.5 is in fact Santa Singh and not Santa Kaur. In relation to allegation of rape committed by the private respondents, rapat No.21 dated 08.03.2018 is alleged to have entered by the police, but no action has been taken. Petitioner has also moved a representation dated 08.03.2018 before respondent No.2 and the same has also met with the same fate.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of Court, Mr. Hittan Nehra, Addl., AG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State. Let requisite copies of petition be supplied to him by learned counsel for the petitioner during course of the day.

In view of nature of order which this Court proposes to pass there is no necessity of calling upon any reply from respondents No.1 to 3 as no order prejudicial to the interest of the parties is being passed.

At this stage, this petition can be disposed of by directing respondent No.2 to have a fair look on the representation made by the petitioner and act in accordance with law without being influenced by any statement of facts recorded hereinabove.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
