On the last date of hearing, when this Court was not inclined to entertain the petition, the petitioner already having been declared to be a proclaimed offender, learned counsel for the petitioner had submitted that he would like to place on record copies of the summons issued to secure his presence by the trial Court, to prove that actually he was never served with such summons.

Today, he submits that he has obtained such copies showing service of summons upon the petitioner but still, the petitioner being willing to surrender before that Court, be admitted to bail.

Having considered the aforesaid contention, the petitioner already having been declared a proclaimed offender earlier, and nothing shown to support the contention made on the last date of hearing, the petition is dismissed.
