The instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been filed by the petitioners for issuance of a direction to official respondent Nos. 2 & 3 to investigate the matter and take legal action against the private respondent Nos. 4 to 7 on the complaint dated 16.03.2018 (Annexure P-2) as per law, as till date no action has been taken by respondent No.2 on the same.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he would be satisfied if respondent No.2 be directed to look into the complaint dated 16.03.2018 (Annexure P-2) and take action in accordance with law, in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mrs. Anju Arora, learned Addl. Advocate General, Punjab, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the State. Three copies of the petition be handed over to her by learned counsel for the petitioner during the course of the day failing which

no action is called for. She submits that complaint dated 16.03.2018 (Annexure P-2) will be decided within a period of four weeks

Without going into the merits of the case, the instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide complaint dated 16.03.2018 (Annexure P-2), within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order and take necessary action in accordance with law.
