The petitioners seek grant of regular bail in case FIR No.35, dated 10.02.2018, under sections 379-B/411/34 IPC, registered at Police Station Govt. Railway Police, Amritsar, District Amritsar City.

2. Custody certificate, dated 01.05.2018, issued by Sh. Rajiv Kumar Arora, PPS, Superintendent, Central Jail, Amritsar, has been filed in Court today and the same is taken on record. According to the certificate, the petitioner has undergone actual custody of two months and eighteen days.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners states that during the pendency of the investigation, the parties have reached an amicable settlement and the petition for quashing of the FIR on the basis of compromise, has also been filed.

4. Learned State counsel does not dispute the aforementioned factual

avermment of learned counsel for the petitioners.

5. Thus, the petition is allowed. Petitioners-Amrik Singh and Hardev Singh @ Lucky, are ordered to be released on regular bail on their furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court concerned at Amritsar.
