Petitioners Satbir Singh @ Sattu and Tinku seek anticipatory bail in case FIR No.0089 dated 16.4.2018 registered against them for offences punishable under Sections 323, 34, 341 and 506 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, in which Section 325 IPC has been added subsequently.

The allegations in nutshell are that on 12.4.2018, when the complainant alongwith his wife and his minor son were going on motorcycle, then they were waylaid by the petitioners Satbir Singh @ Sattu and Tinku alongwith some other unknown boys, who were armed with iron rods and they caused injuries to the complainant as well as to the wife of the complainant.

Notice of this petition was issued to the State vide order dated 26.4.2018 and the petitioners were granted anticipatory bail.

The learned counsel for the complainant has submitted that infact the police is helping the petitioners inasmuch as though it is an offence under Section 326 IPC, which would be made out but no such offence has been added. The learned State counsel has submitted that infact the injuries have been caused on vital part i.e. on head of the complainant that even the wife of complainant had been caused injuries and that in these circumstances, the accused do not deserve the concession of anticipatory bail.

The learned State counsel has informed that the petitioners have since joined investigation.

Having regard to facts and circumstances of the case and the fact that petitioners have joined investigation, the interim directions issued by this Court vide order dated 26.4.2018 are hereby made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioners shall appear before the Investigating Officer as and when directed and fully cooperate with the investigation.
