The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 27 dated 07.02.2018 under Section 379-B IPC, registered at Police Station Model Town, District Hoshiarpur.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the incident is of 25.01.2018 but the FIR was registered on 07.02.2018. Thus, there is an unexplained delay in registration of the FIR. Moreover, investigation is complete but examination of prosecution witnesses has not yet been started. Thus, the petitioner deserves the concession of grant of regular bail as he has been in custody since 08.02.2018.

3. Learned State counsel opposes the prayer on the ground that one mobile phone and Rs. 5500/- cash were recovered from the petitioner. However, it is not disputed that the investigation is complete and that charges have also been framed.

4. Keeping in view the aforementioned facts, I deem it appropriate to grant regular bail to the petitioner. The petition is allowed and the petitioner is

directed to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
