It is seen that despite the order dated 25.04.2018, directing that the SP, Yamunanagar, and the SHO, Police Station Thana Chappar, Yamunanagar, depute adequate number of police officials to escort the petitioners to their place of residence in District Yamunanagar, from the Protection Home, Sector-19, Chandigarh, the needful has not been done by the said respondents, i.e. respondents no.2 and 3.

However, learned State counsel submits that today adequate number of police officials are present in Court from the said police station to escort petitioners to their home, where they will continue to be protected.

That being so, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petition be disposed of.

Consequently, this petition is disposed of with the direction that the lives and liberties of the petitioners will continue to remain protected at

the place where they are residing with respondents no.2 and 3 to ensure such protection.
