Petitioner-Pritpal Singh has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for brevity, 'Cr.P.C.') for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.204 dated 10.07.2015, registered at Police Station City-I, District Abohar, under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion was issued in this case. Learned State counsel put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that the petitioner has been summoned under Section 190 Cr.P.C. by the Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate,

Abohar.

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Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in pursuance of the interim order dated 01.05.2018 passed by this Court, the petitioner has already appeared before the trial Court and has been released on interim bail. He further states that charges have already been framed by the court and the petitioner is regularly appearing before the court.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find that the petitioner is only to face the trial and no useful purpose will be served by sending him to custody. Therefore, finding merit in the present petition, the same is allowed. The order dated 01.05.2018, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute.
