As per the report received from the Mediation Centre,
the parties have settled their dispute by way of amicable settlement, copy
of which has been forwarded to this Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the
petitioners have since joined the investigation, as such, they be granted
concession of pre-arrest bail.

Learned State counsel on instructions from HC Harinder Singh, submits that since the matter has been compromised between the parties, the petitioners have joined the investigation and recovery has been effected from them, therefore, their custodial interrogation is not required.

As such, the interim bail granted to the petitioner – Prem Singh on 9.5.2017 and petitioner Gurpreet Kaur on 22.5.2017 are made absolute, subject to their fulfilling conditions under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
