This is third bail application filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C seeking bail in case FIR No.68 dated 03.10.2016 registered under Sections 307, 353, 186 and 427 IPC at Police Station Mukandpur, District SBS Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case. He is in custody since 03.10.2016. The petitioner is not involved in any other FIR. The last bail application was dismissed on 03.10.2017. Keeping in view the nature of injury, no case under Section 307 IPC is made out. The complainant, Head Constable Kuldeep Singh has been examined. Out of 18 prosecution witnesses, only six so far have been examined.

On the other hand, the learned State counsel opposes

the bail application.

Heard.

The long incarceration of the petitioner and examination of the complainant, Head Constable Kuldeep Singh are fresh circumstances in favour of the petitioner so, without commenting on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed. The petitioner be admitted to bail during the pendency of trial, on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/duty Magistrate concerned.
