Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that FIR No. 58 dated 29.03.2018 having been registered at the instance of the petitioner against respondent no. 5, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under Sections 452, 336, 506 read with Section 34 IPC, and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, the petitioner is now (as alleged) being pressurized to compromise the matter, such pressure being exercised by respondent no. 4, who is shown to be the In-charge of Police Post, Kot Khalsa, District Amritsar.

In respect of his grievance, the petitioner is stated to have made a representation to the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar, dated 06.04.2018, a copy of which has been annexed with the petition as Annexure P-3 with the petition.

Consequently, without going into the merits of the contentions made in the petition, in any manner whatsoever, respondent no. 2, i.e. the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar, is directed to go into the matter and to take a decision as per law on the representation of the petitioner, within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

The petition is disposed of accordingly.
