Petitioner seeks benefit of regular bail pending trial in case FIR No.19, dated 04.02.2018, under Sections 384/420/120-B IPC and Section 13(2) of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988, registered at Police Station City Raikot, Police District Ludhiana Rural, District Ludhiana.

Counsel for the parties have been heard.

FIR has been registered on the statement of Sukhdev Singh. Allegations are that sister of the complainant was married with one Balkar Singh. Balkar Singh is stated to have developed physical relations with the present petitioner and taking advantage of such situation, present petitioner along with co-accused, Inspector Kuldeep Singh have connived and thereby under threat and coercion, have made compromise with Balkar Singh and have taken Rs.30 lakhs from him in Police Station Sadar Raikot.

Learned State counsel, who is on instructions from ASI Jagroop Singh apprises the Court that co-accused, Inspector Kuldeep Singh, Gurjinder Singh Mann, Gurmander Singh as also Paramjit Singh are still on the run.

In the totality of circumstances, this Court is not inclined to extend in favour of the petitioner concession of bail at this stage.

Petition is dismissed.
