Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to the respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondents No.4 to 9.

While issuing notice of motion on 25.04.2018, this Court had directed the respondents No.2 and 3 to ensure that the life and liberty of the petitioners are not put to any harm or threat at the hands of the private respondents or at their behest.

Learned State counsel has produced a copy of the certificate issued by Government Girls Secondary School, Kot Baba Deep Singh, Amritsar showing the date of birth of the petitioner No.1 Gurkirtan Kaur as 07.01.1999. The said document is taken on record.

Heard.

The petitioners are claiming themselves to be major and this fact has not been disputed by the State.

In view of the above, without going into the validity of the marriage, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents No.2 and 3 to take appropriate remedial measures, as warranted by law, on the representation dated 23.04.2018 (Annexure P-4) submitted by the petitioners.

In the meantime, necessary order be passed to ensure that no harm is caused to the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No.4 to 9.
