Petitioner was granted interim protection in this case with a direction to appear before the Trial Court within seven days vide Order dated 26.04.2018. A perusal of the Order Sheet shows that he had not appeared pursuant to the Order. Ultimately vide Order dated 14.08.2018; the interim protection was ordered to be continued; with a further order that if the petitioner does not appear before the Trial Court on or before 24.08.2018 then the interim protection granted in favour of the petitioner shall stand vacated without any further reference to the Court.

There is no representation on the part of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the Complainant and the State Counsel, being instructed by ASI Baldev Singh submit that the petitioner has not appeared before the Trial Court; despite the Order passed by this Court. Rather vide Order dated 20.09.2018 the petitioner has been declared as a

proclaimed offender.

Since it was ordered vide Order dated 14.08.2018 that in case the petitioner does not appear before the Trial Court on 24.08.2018, then, the interim protection shall stand vacated without any further reference to the Court, therefore, in view of above facts no further orders are required in the case.

The petition stands dismissed.
