The petitioner seeks transfer of investigation of FIR No.363, dated 28.12.2017, registered at Police Station Tripari, Patiala, under sections 324, 325 IPC to some other police station.

2. According to the petitioner, one of the accused in the said FIR is her husband and he is posted in the Secretariat Patiala, which is within the jurisdiction of Police Station Tripari and therefore, he is very familiar with the officials of the said police station. Thus, a representation dated 02.04.2018 has been submitted to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala, (Annexure P-1) to transfer the investigation to some other police station, as there is apprehension of bias against the staff of Police Station Tripri. No order has been passed upon the said representation till date.

4. Mr. Amandeep Singh Gill, Sr. DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents. Let three copies of the complete paperbook be supplied to him during the course of the day.

5. The petition is disposed of with direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala, to objectively consider the representation dated 02.04.2018

(Annexure P-1) within three weeks' from the receipt of certified copy of this order and passed a speaking order thereupon in accordance with law.
