GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J.(Oral)

By way of filing this petition, the petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.33 dated 21.2.2018 registered under Sections 341, 324, 506 and 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 (Section 307 IPC was added lateron) at Police Station Barnala, District Barnala and all consequential proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.

Vide order dated 26.4.2018, the parties had been directed to appear before the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Illaq Magistrate so as to get their statements recorded qua the factum of compromise.

Report of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Barnala has been received, wherein it has been reported that the statements of complainant Gursewak Singh and also of the accused have been recorded to the effect that they have compromised the matter with the intervention of

respectables and they have no objection in case the FIR in question is quashed. It has specifically been opined that the parties have entered into compromise voluntarily and without there being any pressure, coercion or undue influence.

In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the present petition is allowed and FIR No.33 dated 21.2.2018 registered under Sections 341, 324, 506 and 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 (Section 307 IPC was added lateron) at Police Station Barnala, District Barnala and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed.
