The petitioner, who is present in person, submits that she has eminent and constant danger to her life and liberty at the hands of private respondents. She is not able to live in her own home with her mother as her mother has also been frightened by the private respondents. She has further stated that she has no place to live without fear.

Considering this aspect of the case, keeping in view the safety of the petitioner, she is sent to Nari Niketan, Chandigarh. ASI Harminder Singh, who is present in Court, is directed to take the petitioner in Nari Niketan, Chandigarh. Learned counsel for the petitioner would also accompany her. The petitioner shall remain there till the cloud of danger to her life and liberty vanishes.
