The petitioner seeks quashing of FIR No.101 dated 16.3.2018 under Sections 324, 452, 323, 427, 506, 34 IPC, Police Station Shimlapuri, District Police Commissionerate, Ludhiana and proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.

Vide order dated 26.4.2018 the parties had been directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate so as to get the statements recorded with regard to the genuineness of the compromise.

Report of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Ludhiana has been received wherein it has been reported that statements of the petitioners

as well as of Karan Verma-complainant have been recorded who have stated that they have compromised the matter and that Karan Verma-complainant has no objection if the FIR is quashed. It has specifically been reported by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Ludhiana that in his opinion the compromise is genuine and has been effected voluntarily without there being any undue influence or coercion.

In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (CrL.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the petition stands allowed and FIR No.101 dated 16.3.2018 under Sections 324, 452, 323, 427, 506, 34 IPC, Police Station Shimlapuri, District Police Commissionerate, Ludhiana and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed.
