GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.22 dated 08.04.2016 under Sections 380, 457, 447, 511, 427, 506, 148 and 149 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, Police Station Nandgarh, District Bathinda and proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.

Vide order dated 26.04.2018 the parties had been directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate so as to get the statements

recorded with regard to the genuineness of the compromise.

Report of learned learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Bathinda has been received to the effect that the statements of complainant-Nirmala Devi and also of the accused namely Mandeep Kumar, Sandeep Kumar, Prem Kumar, Bhim Sain have been recorded to the effect that they have compromised the matter amongst themselves. The complainant has specifically stated that the FIR may be quashed.

The learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Bathinda has specifically opined that compromise has been effected voluntarily without there being any undue influence or coercion.

In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the petition is allowed and FIR No.22 dated 08.04.2016 under Sections 380, 457, 447, 511, 427, 506, 148 and 149 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, Police Station Nandgarh, District Bathinda and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed.
